



# “Our Faith in the Future” CAPITAL CAMPAIGN Final Progress Report 2015

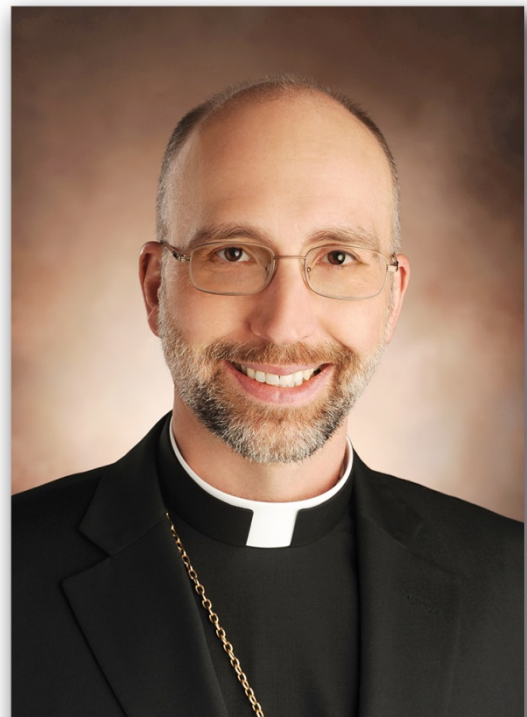
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

## Diocesan-wide Campaign Draws to a Close

The 4-year pledge redemption period is drawing to a close for most people who pledged their support to the 2010 diocesan-wide capital campaign, “Our Faith in the Future.” As a courtesy to those who need more time to fulfill their pledge commitments, the Diocese of Marquette will continue to provide pledge redemption services throughout 2015. The Diocese will also distribute the monies collected to parishes and schools for each quarter that donations are received.

## Overall Impact

As of Dec 31, 2014, nearly \$8.5 million has been distributed as follows:

Parishes	\$3.2 million
Catholic Schools	\$1.4 million
Legacy of Faith	\$1.4 million
UPCSA (2011 only)	\$1.9 million
Campaign Fees	\$0.6 million

Six parishes conducted “piggyback” campaigns to raise additional funds for their parish needs. These parishes raised a total of \$3 million.
