Stewardship – Sharing of our Time, Talent & Treasure

Sharing our Talent: All of us are asked to serve God by serving each other and our neighbor through active participation in at least one of our parish's ministries. Sharing our Treasure: All of us are asked to, on a regular basis, financially support our parish so that we can continue to build up God's kingdom on earth.
