
CHRIST THE KING

The Path from Dream to Reality

Crisis Explained

In July of 2014 the new pastor and the new principal were brought up to speed on the deteriorating condition of the boiler that heated the church and school.

Crisis Explored

Over the next several months the topic of the boiler, and its imminent failure, was repeatedly discussed with the Parish Finance Council, The School Board and the newly formed Parish Council.

Leadership Emerges

A group of dedicated parishioners began meeting to discuss ways to address the heating of our parish plant. Those discussions quickly turned from crisis mode to opportunity. Kevin McShane and Tom Fahey were at the helm of a committee of dedicated and talented parishioners.

Security, Capacity, and Energy

The decision to simply replace the boiler, was replaced by the visionary idea of giving the parish school a physical plant that would meet its needs to 2050 and well beyond!

CK School Foundation Leads the Way

In March of 2015, The Foundation was presented with the new plan, and quickly endorses the vision with a \$500,000 donation predicated on the support of the school community.

The Excitement Grows

In May of 2015, the entire parish and school community gathered in the gym for the unveiling of the new and exciting plans. The support was resounding.

The Fundraising Begins

Small group gatherings, phone calls, letter writing campaigns, and church announcements all resulted in incredible generosity and support. We are truly a blessed parish with extraordinary parishioners and school families.

These collections are comprised of Sunday & Holy Days, Christmas, Easter and Memorials. The total of Sunday and Holy days was \$440,222, a 7.1% reduction from the previous year.

Due to the generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal, Christ The King Parish received a **rebate** of \$15,290.

The Christ The King School
Foundation made numerous
donations to the school. These
donations enable the school to
maintain tuition at an affordable
level and helps to minimize tuition
increase. Parishioners' support of the
Foundation's fundraising efforts is
encouraged for continued donations
to the school.

Separate from the CK2050 project, numerous capital improvements were made. These improvements include completion of the church HVAC system, a new rectory boiler, Regency Room lunch serving area, classroom carpeting, concrete walk in front of church, school tuckpointing and completion of rectory front door security. It must be noted that funds for the rectory boiler were provided by a generous benefactor. The remaining balance of funds from the Parish Endowment was used for the church HVAC completion.


