

## SCRIPT FOR PHONING AND CHECKING IN ON PARISHIONERS

## PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING PROTOCOLS:

- 1. PLEASE TRY TO ENGAGE PARISHIONERS IN A CONVERSATION.
- 2. DON'T MAKE THE PHONE CALL SOUND LIKE A SURVEY.
- 3. PLEASE MAKE ANY ADDITIONAL NOTES IN THE NOTE SECTION PROVIDED ON THE SPREADSHEET YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN.

Good (EVENING/MORNING/AFTERNOON), I am (YOUR NAME) from St. Alfred Parish. **Fr. Charles has asked me to call you and check to see how you and your family are doing**.

- How is your health? How is your family's health?
- Is there anything that the parish can do for you and/or your family?
- Father will be praying for the sick and for special requests at the Masses. Do you have any prayer requests?
- As you might know, we have been live-streaming the Masses on Facebook and just this past weekend on our Website as well. Are you watching our Masses? Do you have a computer and/or smartphone? Do you have Facebook?
- We hope to start sending out regular emails to keep in touch. Do you have an email that you can share with us? (IF THEY HAVE AN EMAIL ON FILE, PLEASE VERIFY THAT IS CORRECT).
- We want to let you know that we also have an online giving option, if you would like to use it to contribute to the parish, please visit our website (PROVIDE WEBSITE ADDRESS IF THE PERSON DON'T KNOW), scroll down and click on the giving button.
- Again, please let us know if we can do anything to serve you and your family. Just call the parish office and leave a voice message.
