- Making personal phone calls: a group of volunteers are calling the elderly and the parish has now expanded the call list to a phone tree to reach all the parishioners.
- Using technology to engage their parishioners: *streaming daily Masses, Holy Hour and prayers such as Divine Mercy Chaplet, Rosary, etc.*
