The successful candidate will be a practicing Catholic with an appreciation and passion for the mission of the Diocese of Wilmington with a deep-rooted commitment to Catholic values. Must have broad exposure to all facets of development, including data management and analysis, annual giving, major gifts, planned giving, and capital campaign planning and implementation. He/she must have evidence of understanding and the ability to articulate the accomplishments and goals of a complex organization, along with sound judgment skills necessary for establishing and maintaining effective personal relationships with donors, clergy, parishioners, and staff. Visionary and strategic planning capabilities to be applied toward the development of an innovative fundraising program, and the leadership necessary to ensure its successful implementation is essential.
