On-Going Talent/Ministry Promotion during the Year (one week a month for those parishes choosing no fall renewal)

Date	Description	Parish Actions
JANUARY	One Ministry for One Year promotion	January is ideal for Talent renewal. Does not involve money so beginning of the year is a great opportunity as people look to self-improvement to start the year. Explain the one-year commitment
FEBRUARY	Liturgical ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	The season of Lent would be a good time to promote your liturgical ministries (Lector, Eucharistic minister, Choir, Usher, etc.)
MARCH	Building & Grounds ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	Opportunity to promote this need during the start of the Spring months particularly in preparation for the Easter season
APRIL	Gifts/Skills/Hobbies promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	Select a week during the month to ask parishioners what particular gifts & abilities they possess that could be used as need arises. Consider soliciting response through ParishStaq using URL link.
MAY	Volunteer Appreciation and opportunity to solicit for immediate needs at the parish (One Ministry for One Year)	Use this month as an opportunity to recognize your volunteers by thanking them publicly. Perhaps small reception after all Masses that weekend to engage those volunteers and solicit feedback.
JUNE	Councils/Commissions ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	With Councils on hiatus during the summer months, use this time to emphasize the leadership aspect of the parish and promote any upcoming vacancies that need to be filled by the fall.
JULY	Hospitality/Welcoming/Event Planning ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	Use this time to speak about the importance of hospitality and welcoming within the parish community. With the approach of fall, lining up volunteers now for the busy fall season (including events) is critical
AUGUST	Faith Formation ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	As the school year rapidly approaches, highlight these ministries in preparation for fall Religious Education, Youth and Young adult ministries.
SEPTEMBER	Outreach Ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	With the start of Fall and the winter months (and inclement weather just ahead), use this time to focus on those outreach ministries of the parish (SVDP, Clothing bank, Food bank, etc.)
OCTOBER	Communication & Technology ministry promotion (One Ministry for One Year)	With the busy fall season in full swing and many events occuring at the facilities, this is good time of year to highlight the technology needs at your parish.
NOVEMBER	Specific Ministry promotion for upcoming holidays. Including One-Ministry/One Year & Talent Pools.	Emphasizing upcoming needs for the busy holiday months. Also use this time to explain the concept of Talent Pools within your parish
DECEMBER	Volunteer Appreciation & Evaluation of current ministries (One Ministry for One Year)	Thank and follow-up with those who applied and those who are currently serving in a ministry. Use time at end of year to evaluate all ministries

On-Going Renewal of Talent/Ministry

Tasks during the Year

ш	Select one weekend a month (whatever works best at your parish) to highlight specific ministries.
	Use the timeline above as a guide or create your own annual timeline.
	Consider using a witness speaker that weekend to talk about a particular ministry.
	Prepare your Witness Speaker by giving them the Talent Witness Guide by clicking here and have them
	outline their witness talk, receive feedback from you and practice talk in church.
	Whether it is the witness speaker, Pastor, or Deacon, use this opportunity to tie the highlighted ministries
	into the overall message of stewardship. This is the opportunity to make the connection.
	Whichever weekend of the month you choose, use the bulletin announcements below (or your own) as well
	as the prayers of the faithful in all your communications (bulletin, website, email, social media, etc.).
	Consider inserting expanded information (such as a flyer, e-flyer, or weblink) about the specific month's
	highlighted ministries in your bulletin, on your website, and social media.
	Consider a virtual talent promotion. Can you create groups of similar ministries (outreach ministry, liturgical
	ministry, leadership ministries, etc.) and hold a 30-minute session on TEAMS or ZOOM for individuals that
	may be interested in that particular group of ministries?
	Make sure you have a clear pathway for accepting inquiries for those who are interested in receiving more
	information or who wish to sign up. You may not want to use a paper form (since you are only highlighting 1-
	3 ministries) and simply direct people to their ParishStaq profile or your mobile friendly website where a list
	of ministries, detailed information about those ministries, and ability to sign up for a ministry is available. This
	would imply that your parish has a section on its website for Stewardship of Talent and that you are able to
	direct any inquiries from interested parishioners to the appropriate contact person. This could be a portal on
	your website or an email address to a specific person. It would most likely require people to use their mobile
	device at Mass during this on-going monthly Talent renewal. If you use ParishStaq, it has Form capability built
	into the system. You can send URL link to parishioners who can submit their Talent and Ministry information.
	Admins can update the personal profile My Fit Abilities section and populate Ministry Groups from this
	form data.
	If you are suggesting the use of Talent Pools, remember that they should only be used for specific ministries
	(i.e., stuffing envelopes, building/grounds clean up, funerals, preparing holiday donation baskets, etc.) and
	should not be used for ministries that require on-going scheduling.
	Consider using a volunteer to assist with preparing the timeline and scheduling/crafting the message for that
	month's ministry highlight. This person would also assist with any required follow-up (an absolute must).
	Don't forget to publicly thank those who expressed interest in serving in a particular ministry the following
	weekend.
