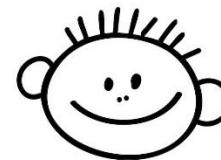

What is Stewardship?

A steward is someone who receives God's gifts gratefully, develops those gifts responsibly, shares those gifts lovingly in justice with others, and makes a return with interest to the Lord.

From a young age, it is important for children to understand that the God-given gifts entrusted to them should be used for the glory of God in service of their neighbour. This sacrificial idea will help them to grow in holiness and become little saints. The invitation to use our God-given gifts in a way that is pleasing to God calls for creativity and boldness because each child has enormous potential, and it is important to nurture that within the framework of the Church.

As Christ himself says, "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them; for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." (Matt.19:14)

A few key areas to help your child grow in union with God include attending Sunday Mass, monthly Confession (if they are of age), spending 5-10 minutes in prayer with your child, reading to them about the lives of the Saints, etc.
