A steward is someone who receives God's gifts gratefully, develops those gifts responsibly, shares those gifts lovingly in justice with others, and makes a return with interest to the Lord.

Stewardship is a profound disposition of the heart and mind which transforms everything we do. It is an awareness that each of us has been entrusted with many gifts, and that all will benefit if we fruitfully share them for the glory of God in the service of our neighbour.

It is in living out a stewardship way of life that our baptismal call to discipleship is fulfilled through the mission and ministry of our parish.
