

Gift Processing & Reporting





- Money Counters open mail to look for CASH
- Create a pile for CASH gifts using the CASH Batch Card
- All other gifts go into a different pile
- "Already made my gift" envelopes are collected in a separate pile and kept at the parish for future reference
- Create another pile of envelopes for Refusals, Inactive, Deceased and Divorced and sent to us bound with the yellow batch card

1. Parish Check and one "VISITOR" envelope	
DO NOT send any cash in the mail. Instead: Deposit all cash into your parish account and write a check* for that amount payable to <i>Diocese of Orlando</i> .	Total amount of CASH collected (equals amount of Parish Check):
*The check should include all cash removed from individual parishioner pledge envelopes included with the CASH Batch Card plus any loose change/cash recorded on your "VISITOR" envelope	Parish Check Number:
2. Total Number of Envelopes

Place all envelopes into an appropriate package for mailing.
(Please include the Parish Check or DSAS Check Request Form, one Visitor Envelope
and a copy of this completed Donation Summary Report.)

In order to expedite the processing of your transmittal, please do not use paperclips, binder clips tape or staples

Please note: A parish check or DSAS Check Request Form must accompany all transmittals.

Gift Processing & Reporting





- Mail your transmittal to our Lockbox Processor using a USPS Tracking Number
- They log it in with the date mailed and the date received
- It is put in the queue for processing in the order received
