- Serve as a Catechist's assistant in Faith Formation.


Stewardship of Treasure



Stewardship of treasure calls us to recognize that money is a gift from God, earned by using our God-given talents and time. I am asked to give back a portion of my treasure in gratitude for all that God has given me.

Some of the ways I can share my treasure include:

- Give a portion of my allowance, salary, or tips to the parish offertory.
- Participate in Operation Rice Bowl during Lent.
- Participate in CROP Walk or other charity fundraiser.



- Collect food, toys and clothing for needy families.
- Participate in Youth Group fundraising activities.
- Participate in church or community projects to aid needy people locally or in third-world countries.
