After the Ascension of Jesus. Peter and the apostles gathered to figure out how to fill the void left after Judas betrayed Jesus and ended up taking his own life. They had determined that a new apostle would need to be named to bring the number of apostles back to 12, representing the 12 tribes of Isreal. The apostles decided that the next apostle needed to be someone who had followed Jesus from the very beginning, when he was baptized by St. John the Baptist. He needed to have seen the miracles himself and to have been witness to the resurrection. There were only two men of the 120 followers who qualified, Joseph called Barsabus (also known as Justus) and Matthias. The apostles prayed. "You. Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which of these two you have chosen to take the place in this apostolic ministry from which Judas turned away to go to his own place." (Acts 1:24-25) Then they "cast lots" and the lot fell to Matthias, thus he became an apostle.

St. Matthias was the first apostle who was not hand selected by Jesus but was chosen through the apostles. This demonstrates the continuation of the apostolic ministry - meaning that the apostles were given the ability to pass on the sacred power of their ordination to others as their successors. This was a gift from Jesus to His first apostles and has continued to this day. As the Church has continued to grow, others have been picked and, through grace, they have been ordained as bishops - including our own Bishop Warfel and Bishop Fleming.

This unbroken succession started with St. Matthias, who was then named as one of the patron saints of the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings. And it is in his honor that we named our first Giving Circle.


