Who can enter the contest?

Any incoming or outgoing middle school student enrolled in a Diocese of Orlando Catholic school, parish faith formation, religious education, youth ministry or other catechetical formation program during the 2022-23 academic year.

Requirements:

A 2-page (max) essay formatted: Times New Roman, 12 point font, double spaced, standard margins.
