#GivingTuesday is an annual day of giving fueled by the power of social media and collaboration. Celebrated on the Tuesday following Thanksgiving and the widely recognized Black Friday, Small Business Saturday and Cyber Monday, #GivingTuesday kicks off the charitable season, when many donors focus on their holiday and end-of-year giving.

### **Champion Grant**

They created a comprehensive plan which included setting a goal to purchase a new vehicle to transport program participants; securing a matching gift; enlisting peer-topeer fundraisers; and sharing personal impact stories of individuals who have benefitted from their services.

#### **Honorable Mentions:**

**Our Lady of Lourdes/Lourdes Academy, Daytona Beach** - Fr. Phil secured a matching gift, shared grant opportunities, promoted to parish and school families with pulpit and bulletin announcements.

St. Michael Indian School (SMIS) educates 342 students this academic year through in-person, hybrid, and virtual learning. Over 96% of high school graduates continue their studies in post-secondary programs with colleges locally, in-state, and nationally. Just over half of the students enrolled at St. Michael receive funding from the Arizona Tax Credit tuition support organizations with roughly 87% of all students on financial aid.

Recent Donors

SMIS opened in 1902 and in 2022 will begin celebrating 120 years of continuous operation. The school was founded by Saint Katharine Drexel, 95% of staff are Native American and 100% of staff are from the local community with 52% of alumni faculty. St. Michael is a member of the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) and is accredited through the AdvancED Accreditation Commission and Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA). SMIS is the only Catholic high school in the Diocese of Gallup and the only Catholic education option in the Navigo Nation.

The mission of the school is to provide students from local Native American communities with a quality education that is rooted in Catholic values, is sensitive to Native heritage, teaches leadership skills, and enables students to contribute to a culturally diverse world. This is instilled in students in all grade levels with Navajo Language and Culture one of the school's 2021 focus goals.

SMIS competes in 1A Arizona athletics and most recently had two girls basketball team members sign to compete at the collegiate level this fall, while SMIS also celebrated their first softball signing for a pitcher of the team.
