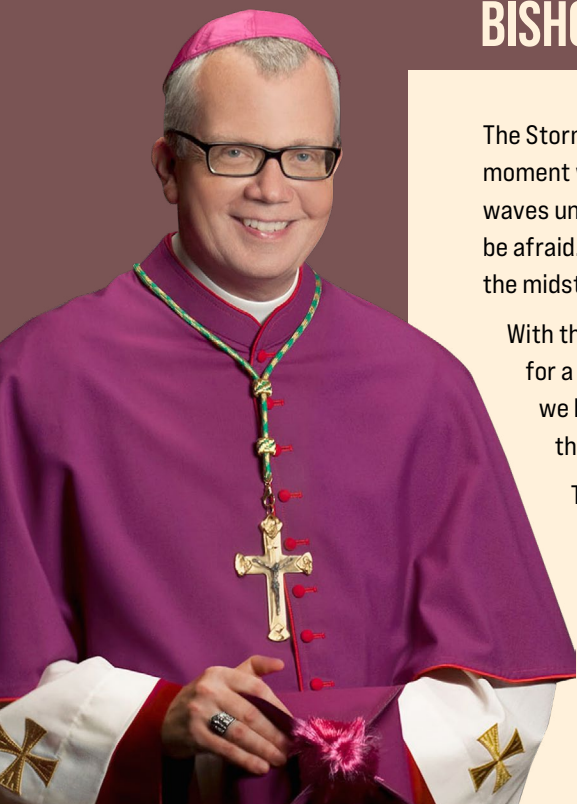

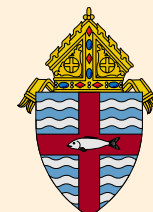
Whenever people are in need, they often look to the Church for comfort and assistance. Like the Apostle's boat, a place of refuge, protected and
