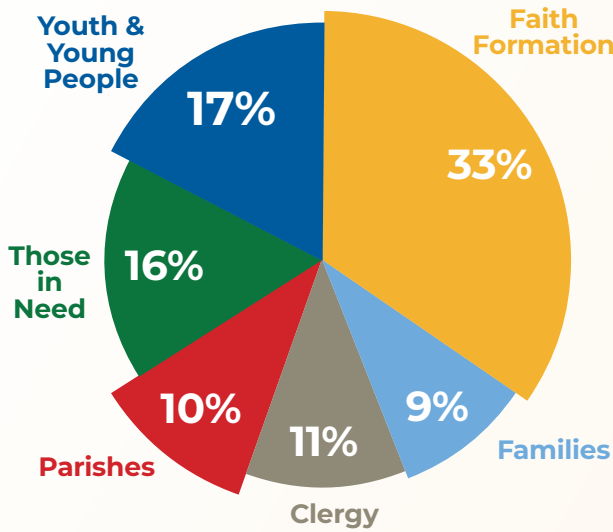

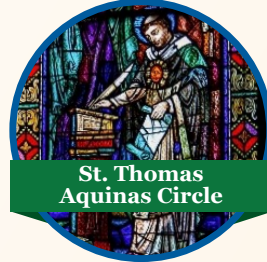
St. Francis of Assisi Circle

\$500-\$999 annually



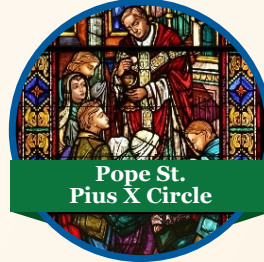
St. Juliana of Liege Circle

THOSE IN NEED

Mother Teresa Shelter serves the homeless in our community with meals, a place to wash their clothes and shower. Together their mission is to help with the daily necessities of life and to serve the whole person by seeing Christ in each person they meet.

The Diocese is committed to reaching and engaging youth, young adults, and college-age students through a vibrant experience of the Catholic faith. These ministries promote interest in religious vocations and help form confident Catholics who will one day lead families and businesses.



FAITH FORMATION
