



Diocesan Stewardship 2022

Once a year, we conduct our Annual Diocesan Stewardship Appeal to support our diocesan ministries. I would like to thank the parish for the great support given for the 2021 Appeal. We had excellent participation and were able to make our goal for the well-being of our diocese. The theme Bishop Malloy has chosen for this year's appeal is "Do You Love Me?" (John 21:16) St. Peter gave his "yes" to this question asked by Jesus and became the leader of the Church. Jesus asks us to give our "yes" so that we can be joined to him and the Church in an intimate bond.

This Appeal supports all of our diocesan ministries. Seminarian education is supported through diocesan stewardship. Our parish has been blessed by the presence of numerous seminarians who will become our future priests. St. Bridget is a great place for seminarians to experience ministry and parish life. The Appeal also supports the Permanent Diaconate Office, Lay Ministry Formation, Catholic Charities and other social service ministries, and the offices that oversee youth ministry, marriage preparation, religious education, and Catholic schools. Those are just a few of the ministries that receive support from the Annual Appeal.

Each parish is given a target amount toward the overall diocesan budget. For the 2022 Appeal, our parish is asked to contribute \$117,813.00 as our fair share of the diocesan budget. This reflects a small increase from the previous year. There will be a pledge envelope coming in the mail in mid-April. If you made a pledge last year, that amount will be noted on the envelope in the mail. For the 2022 Appeal, please prayerfully consider a pledge of \$300, which can be paid over the course of the year. Some may be able to pledge more and others less in light of your circumstances. It is also possible to make your pledge online at www.rockforddiocese.org/donate to donate easily and securely. It is important that we make our target because any shortfall will need to be made up out of our operating budget. Any amount raised over the target comes back to the parish, which can be used for our ministry needs. We are appreciative of any support so whatever you can contribute will be grate-





My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ ...



Before the Appeal

How can you be of assistance to your Pastor?

- Organize Speakers (recorded for social media) could be Deacons, Ministry Formation alumni, Seminarians, etc.
- Bulletin images (up to 3 weeks before).
- Prayers of the Faithful.
- How does the Appeal help those in the parish (bulletin articles, ads, social media post, etc.).

Promotional Ideas – from parishes

- Use video on FlockNote or offer video on YouTube with updates about the parish and then mention the appeal in these videos (multiple parishes do this).
- Have the office staff and parishioners work together not a one person job (multiple parishes said this).
- Send information to parishioners via FlockNote before the appeal opens about how the Diocesan Appeal makes a difference to the parish. A video follow up from the pastor works great.
- The pastor gave a very good presentation about why the appeal is important and he did this more than one time (multiple parishes do this).
- Increasing Mass attendance helps with the appeal and with the parish in general (all parishes said this).
- Call parishioners who you haven't seen or who haven't given in a while to check on them a short conversation could jumpstart giving AND Mass attendance!
- Send a follow up parish appeal on your own, or use us to do it in July/August (or put in bulletin)
- Use a QR code to direct people to the Diocesan Appeal online giving page

Promotional Ideas – from parishes (p2)

- We asked each parish family to consider giving a specific dollar amount to the appeal (multiple parishes do this, it seems particularly mentioned by parishes with higher Hispanic populations).
- Focus on the breakdown of how the appeal funds are used we referenced the circle graph in the appeal brochure it really helped people understand (multiple parishes said this).
- We talked about how the diocesan ministries work throughout the diocese and how the diocese is managed sometimes people just don't understand how it works, and this was helpful to our people (multiple parishes said this).
- Our parishioners appreciated knowing that the diocese works hard to not inflate its budget and they appreciated
 the information of how the appeal is used.
- We showed the appeal video at Mass and then we had it on where people congregated after Mass, as well we had treats after Mass that day (multiple parishes said this).

Promotional Ideas – from parishes (p3)

- We show the video at Mass and then we keep the in-pew envelopes out for a long time.
- We keep everyone updated in the bulletin on where we are with the appeal it is an achievable number so people know that even if they give a little it will help us reach the goal (multiple parishes said this).
- One of our retired priests in residence encourages people to give to the appeal.
- Pastor has been working with the Hispanic population (pastor is also Hispanic) about how important the appeal is to our diocese. We're finding education is key, especially for those families who are new to the United States.
- Our parish has a goal of no debt, so part of this effort is to do well with the appeal.
- We share stories about how we use our parish appeal refunds they makes a difference here!
