This Christ-centered Ministry also provides emergency shelter for homeless individuals and families, food for more than 400 families each month, and emergency food supplies, clothing, and other services.

The *Catholic Youth and Young Adult Ministry (CYM)* also focuses on developing Christian values in young people through ministries that catechize, evangelize, and promote social justice through service. CYM also provides opportunities for young people to lead on the diocesan level through the Youth Leadership Team. The CYM Office encourages and promotes good sportsmanship through CYM Sports.
