



VOCATIONS

Every parish needs a priest to shepherd and lead their community. Deacons are ordained ministers and important servants of the Church. It takes years of formation to become a priest or deacon and a significant investment of time and money on this journey. Supporting the CSA helps ease the financial commitment of these faith leaders during their education and continuing formation. Our Diocese is blessed to have had three ordinations to the priesthood in May of 2023 and have at least three more in seminary. Formation for each seminarian can cost well over \$50,000 a year.
