





Clergy Formation:

Offered to those with a defined mission, such as priesthood or membership of a religious order. Such information involved a program spiritual and academic training.

Life, Charity & Justice:

The three theological virtues are faith, hope and charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13, Charity is translated as "love" and is the virtue by which Catholics demonstrate their love of God above all things.

Discipleship & Evangelization:

Christ fruits, demonstrates the love of God through both practical and spiritual needs of the poor, the outcast, and those Jesus would consider "the least of my brothers." It inspires to live out their God-given identity and calling.




